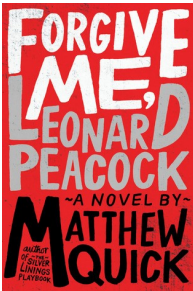


Exit, Pursued by a Bear by E. K. Johnston

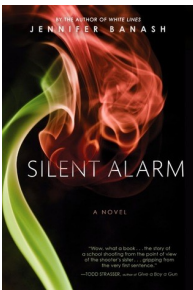


Forgive Me, Leonard Peacock by Matthew Quick

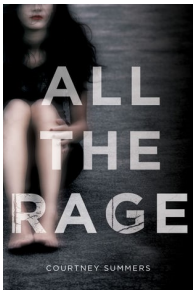


Silent Alarm by Jennifer Banash

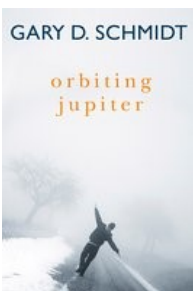


All the Rage by Courtney Summers
