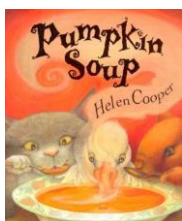

COZY SWEATERS, AND THESE GREAT BOOKS!**

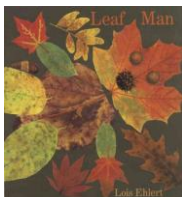
PICTURE BOOKS

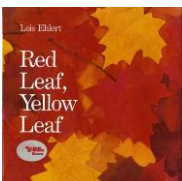

A man made of leaves blows away, traveling wherever the wind may take him.

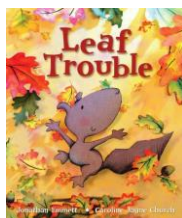

A young squirrel panics when the leaves on his tree change color and fall, but he feels better when his mother tells him about autumn.

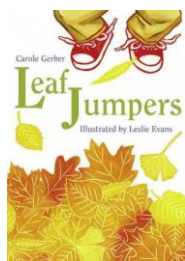

A child experiences the colors and textures of fall.

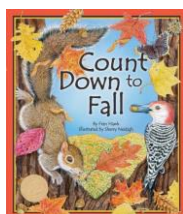

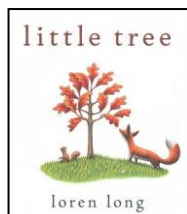

Count backwards from ten to one during one of the most colorful times of the year. Learn about the bright, colorful leaves and the trees from which they fall.

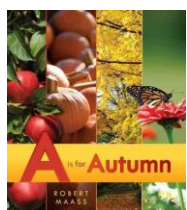

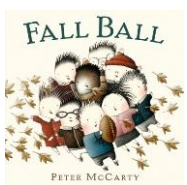

Photographs and simple text present a variety of things seen in the fall.

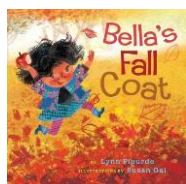

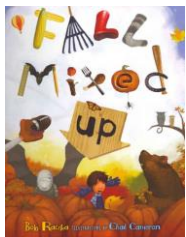

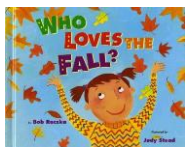

The delights of autumn are described in mixed-up verse and illustrations, and the reader is challenged to uncover the errors.

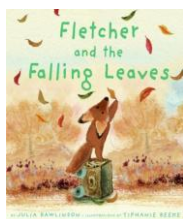

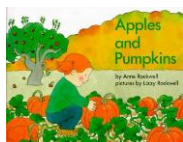

When his favorite tree begins to lose its leaves, Fletcher the fox worries that it is sick, but instead a magical sight is in store for him.

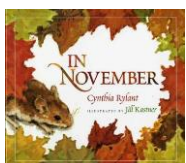

In preparation for Halloween night, a family visits Mr. Comstock's farm to pick apples and pumpkins.

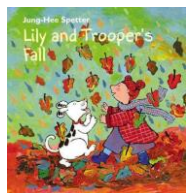

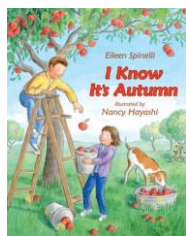
Describes the autumn activities and traditions that November's cooling temperatures bring.

Stein, David Ezra. [Leaves](#)

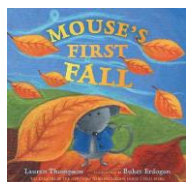

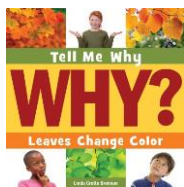
Mouse and Minka experience the delights of nature on a windy autumn day.

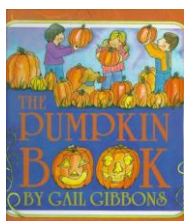
Brennan, Linda Crotta. [Why? Leaves Change Color](#)

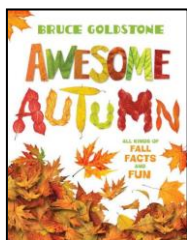

Gibbons, Gail. [The Pumpkin Book](#)

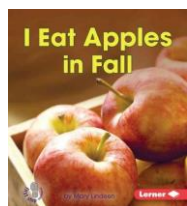

This title examines different properties of fall apples, including such things as color and shape. Readers will learn to observe the world around them as well as to spot signs of seasonal changes in nature.

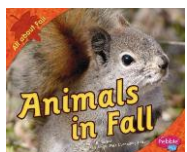

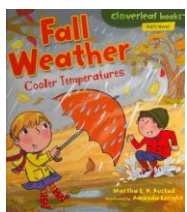
