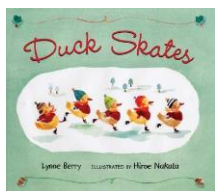
### **PICTURE BOOKS**

Several animals sleep snugly in Nicki's lost mitten until the bear sneezes.

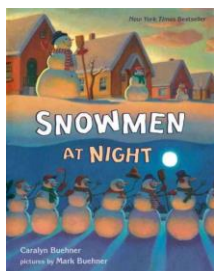

When Clifford, the big red dog, is feeling sad, Emily Elizabeth and her friends do everything they can think of to cheer him up.

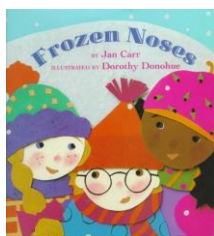

Snowmen play games at night when no one is watching.

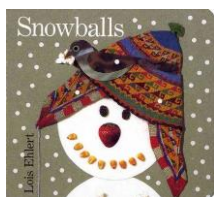

A snowman comes alive as the child building it adds pieces during the first ten days of winter.

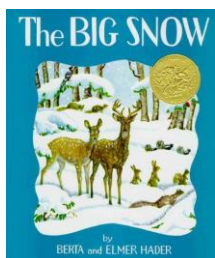

Despite their elaborate preparations for the winter, the animals and birds are delighted by a surprise banquet after a big snow.

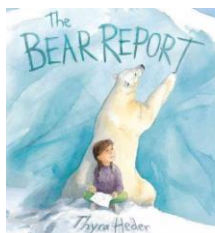

A father and his two sons spend a perfect day sledding together.

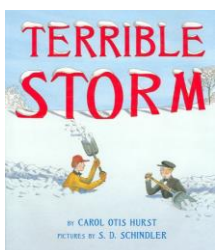

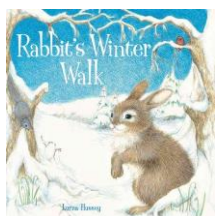

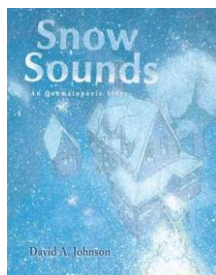

While Little Girl is away on winter vacation, her toys, Lumphy, StingRay, and Plastic, decide to go outside and learn more about snow.

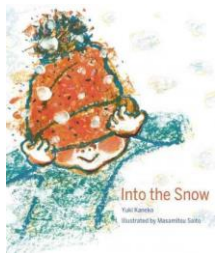

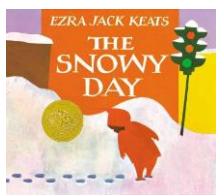

Expression of the sensations a day playing in the snow, ending with the warmth of home, mom and - of course - hot chocolate.

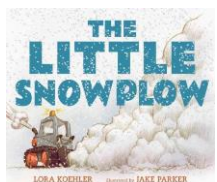

The adventures of a little boy in the city on a very snowy day.

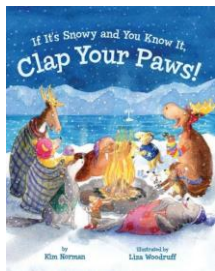

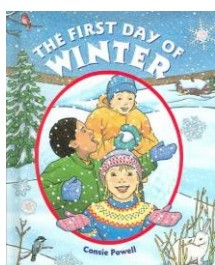

Two families--a large one that lives in a house and the other a tiny one that lives in a snow globe, look forward to a big snowstorm.

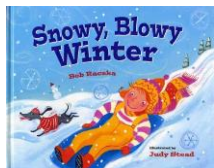

Illustrations and simple rhyming text portray winter activities, from snowman-building, sledding, and sitting by a fire to feeding birds.

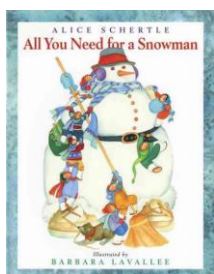

Lists everything that one needs to build the perfect snowman, from the very first snowflake that falls.

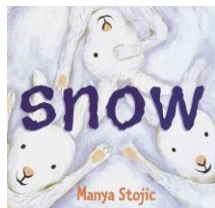

The heartwarming tale of one little lamb's first snowy adventure.

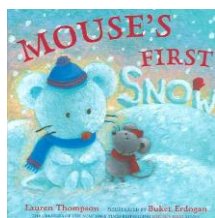

Mouse tries many new things when he and his father go out and play in the snow.

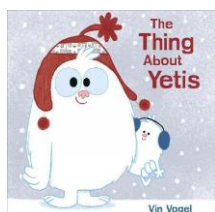

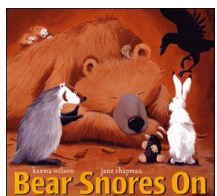


Vogel, Vin. [The Thing about Yetis.](#)

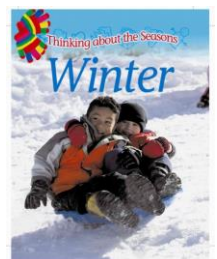
## NON-FICTION BOOKS

Looks at some of the things people think about in relation to winter, and discusses how the season affects people, animals, and the growing cycle.

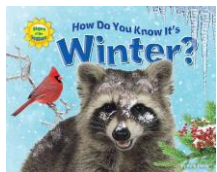

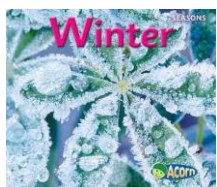
