

Longwood Public Library Minecraft Code of Conduct

The Longwood Public Library offers Minecraft programs for both our school-age and teenage patrons. We play the Minecraft.edu version of the game, which is played on the Library's server.

All users who play on the Library's server are expected to maintain a certain standard of behavior. These standards are essential to ensure that all players have a positive game experience. Anyone who is not able to follow this code of conduct will be asked to leave the game immediately and may be temporarily or permanently banned from future Minecraft programs, depending on the severity of the offense. Any additional policies, rules and regulations of the Longwood Public Library pertaining to patron behavior while in the Library also apply during this program.

- 1. No Griefing:** "Griefing" is defined as "intentionally ruining someone's play experience". This includes (but is not limited to) spamming lava or water over structures, vandalizing structures to make people angry at you, or wholesale destruction without clear purpose.
- 2. No Theft:** Entering other player's rooms or dwellings without their permission is strictly prohibited at any point during the game. You are not permitted to use any item that you do not gather yourself or acquire legitimately from another person.
- 3. Chat:** Abusive or derogatory language is not acceptable. Do not harass any other player for any reason, either through texting within the game or in-person.
- 4. Settings:** Do not change any of the pre-set settings unless granted permission by the Moderator.
- 5. Nether/Ender Dragon:** This dimension will be available at the discretion of the Moderator. Any Dragon Egg that is found belongs to the Moderator and cannot be used to spawn a Dragon.
- 6. Moderators:** Game Moderators and Administrators may go anywhere they please in the execution of their duties, which includes random spot checks. All instructions given by the Moderators regarding game play should be followed immediately. If you have requests or questions for the Moderators, please raise your hand and be patient.
