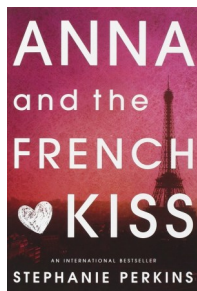

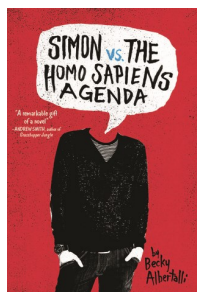


To All the Boys I've Loved Before by Jenny Han

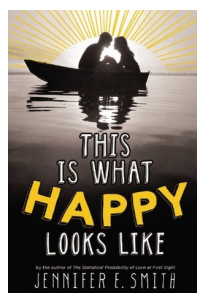


Simon vs. the Homo Sapiens Agenda by Becky Albertalli
