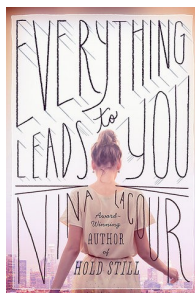


Love and First Sight by Josh Sundquist

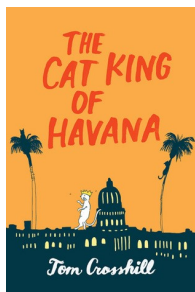


The Summer of Chasing Mermaids by Sarah Ockler

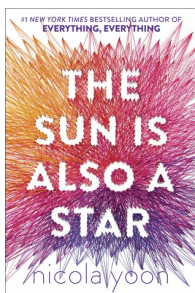


The Cat King of Havana by Tom Crosshill
