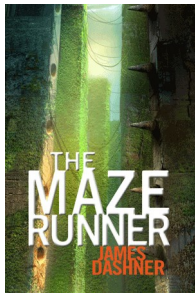

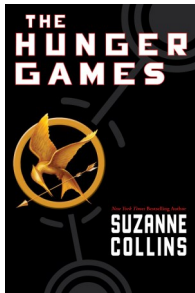


### The Maze Runner by James Dashner

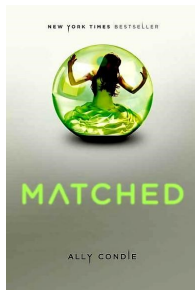


### The Hunger Games by Suzanne Collins

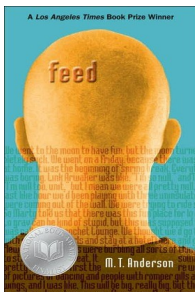


### Matched by Ally Condie

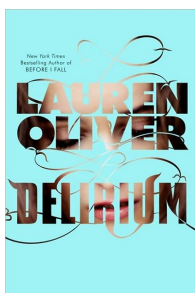


### Feed by M. T. Anderson
