







[Snowmen at Night](#) by Caralyn Buehner
Snowmen play games at night when no one is watching. (BUE)




[The Magic Rabbit](#) by Annette Cate


[Duck](#) by Randy Cecil


[Gator](#) by Randy Cecil
When the amusement park where he had been a happy animal closes, Gator decides to explore the outside world but finds it is a very lonely place. (CEC)




[Diary of a Fly](#) by Doreen Cronin
A young fly discovers, day by day, that there is a lot to learn about being an insect, including the dangers of flyswatters and that heroes come in all shapes and sizes. (CRO)




[Diary of a Spider](#) by Doreen Cronin

When Strega Nona leaves him alone with her magic pasta pot, Big Anthony is determined to show the townspeople how it works. (DEP)




[Un-Brella](#) by Scott Franson

Little sister has no problem eating one hare, two snakes, and three ants, but when she gets to ten peas, she throws up quite a mess. (GRO)




[How to Catch a Star](#) by Oliver Jeffers

While he was trying his best to help a penguin that has shown up at his door, a boy journeys all the way to the South Pole, only to realize that the penguin was never lost. (JEF)




[The Incredible Book Eating Boy](#) by Oliver Jeffers

Henry loves to eat books, until he begins to feel quite ill and decides that maybe he could do something else with the books he has been devouring. (JEF)




[Harry and His Bucket Full of Dinosaurs](#) by R. Schuyler Hooke

Max sails to the land of the wild things, where he becomes their king. (SEN)




