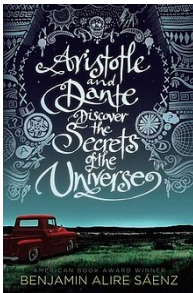

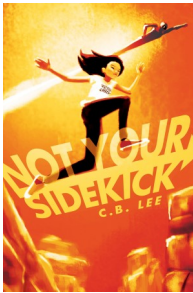


### Aristotle and Dante Discover the Secrets of the Universe by Benjamin Alire Saenz

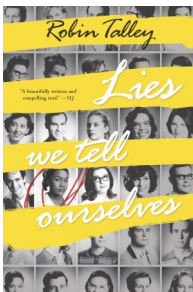


### Not Your Sidekick by C. B. Lee

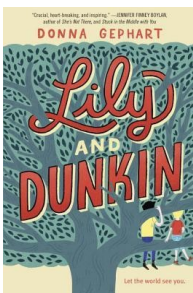


### If I Was Your Girl by Meredith Russo
