


## Reading Aloud to 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade


Allard, Harry. [Miss Nelson is Missing](#)

A stray dog in New York City is adopted by a taxi driver, with whom he thereafter rides and shares adventures each day. ( PICTURE BOOKS BAR)




Best, Cari. [Shrinking Violet](#)


Creech, Sharon. [A Fine, Fine School](#)


Hoffman, Mary. [Amazing Grace](#)


Long, Melinda. [Pirate's Don't Change Diapers](#)


Norman, Lissette. [My Feet Are Laughing](#)

Douglas' stinky, smelly feet are overlooked when he and Dolores realize they have found true love. (PICTURE BOOKS PAL)




Plourde, Lynn. [Science Fair Day](#)


Reiss, Mike. [The Boy Who Looked Like Lincoln](#)

Stanley is excited about Crazy Hair Day at school, until he discovers that he has gotten the date wrong. ( PICTURE BOOKS SAL)




Stevens, Janet [The Great Fuzz Frenzy](#)
