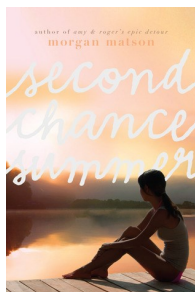


The Stars of Summer by Tara Dairman

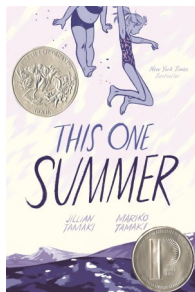


Second Chance Summer by Morgan Matson

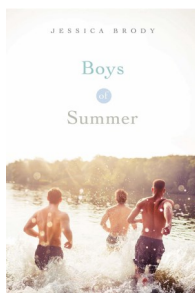


This One Summer by Mariko Tamaki
