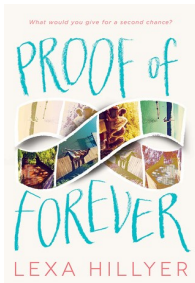


### The Edge of Forever by Melissa E. Hurst

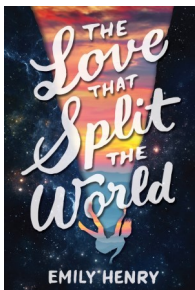


### Proof of Forever by Lexa Hillyer

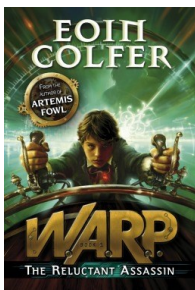


### The Love that Split the World by Emily Henry

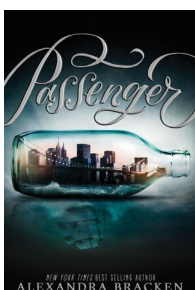


### The Reluctant Assassin by Eoin Colfer
