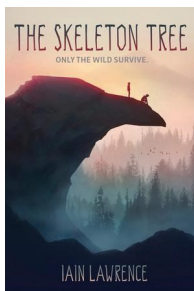

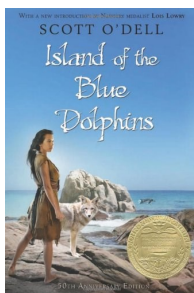


### The Skeleton Tree by Iain Lawrence

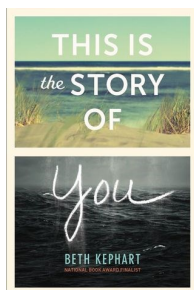


### Island of the Blue Dolphins by Scott O'Dell

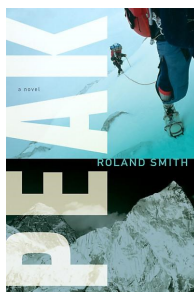


### This Is the Story of You by Beth Kephart
