


Graceling by Kristin Cashore






The Demon King by Cinda Williams Chima (The Seven Realms, book 1)




The Girl of Fire and Thorns by Rae Carson (Fire and Thorns trilogy, book 1)


Gregor the Overlander by Suzanne Collins (The Underland Chronicles, book 1)
