


### Corsets and Clockwork edited by Trisha Telep


### Curio by Evangeline Denmark


### Legacy of the Clockwork Key by Kristin Bailey





### Airman by Eoin Colfer


After Conor is branded a traitor and imprisoned, he plans a daring escape from prison by way of a flying machine that he must design, build, and trust to carry him to safety.

Fever Crumb has been raised as an engineer, but at age fourteen she begins to learn startling truths about her past while facing danger in the present.




